YOU are responsible for the safety and roadworthiness of your vehicle. In the event of an accident, and YOU have been negligent, careless or reckless in anyway, causing loss, damage or injury, YOU MAY BE LIABLE TO OTHERS, such as the circuit operator, Gear Club members – drivers, owners or spectators.

Your GEAR CLUB SIGN-ON SHEET must be filled out and processed in the meeting room BEFORE you complete your paperwork in the QR office. ALL sections of your Sign-on Sheet must be completed ... name, description of car, colour, year of manufacture and racing number if applicable. By completing this information, this helps our Editor, as he scans through an enormous number of photos, trying to match up with member's details you supply.

Have YOU actually read the Participants Code of Driving Behaviour on the top of your driver's Sign-on Sheet? It is your responsibility that you read it, as you are asked to sign this document "THAT YOU HAVE READ AND ACCEPTED THE ABOVE CODE."

ALL drivers must attend the compulsory driver's briefing at 9:00 am. Those drivers that arrive later may be asked to attend a mid-morning briefing before going out on track. Ensure that you leave early enough to beat the traffic.

The Committee has noticed that non-members are taking seats at the briefing, whilst drivers are having to stand outside, missing important information they are required to hear. We ask that only GEAR club members attend the briefing please.
