## NOTICE FROM THE 2022/23 MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

As happens every year at the Annual General Meeting (AGM), all positions on the Management Committee are declared vacant, and a new Committee is formed for the next year. The new Committee is either appointed or elected, depending on the number of nominations. Nominations for the 2023/24 Management Committee should be received by the Secretary well ahead of the AGM.

The 2022/23 Committee, with the exception of John Partington, is prepared to stand again, and nominations have been received by the Secretary. The Committee has found a willing nominee in **Neil Sivyer** to fill the vacancy, and his nomination has been received.

The 2022/23 Committee wishes to advise the membership, that should the members choose to re-elect/re-appoint the 2022/23 Committee for the next year, we will amend the VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES for production sedan and sports cars as outlined in the Category A eligibility criteria.

The amendment will change the cut-off date from a fixed date to a rolling 30 year limit. This brings the cut-off date into line with other similar car clubs and with Qld Transport SIV's regulations.

It is hoped that by giving the membership ample warning and time to materially respond to the Secretary, this amendment will be embraced without undue dissent.

## **Up Next....Morgan Park**

Our Committee has arranged another GEAR Track Day at the Morgan Park Circuit, Warwick on 23rd August 2023.

The track gate will open at 7:30, and the plan is to have sign-on from 7:45, a drivers briefing at 8:30 and on track by 9:00, with the day finishing at around 2:30pm.

Members are welcome to leave car and trailers at the circuit the previous afternoon up until 4:00pm. The track cost will be \$75 per driver and all drivers will need an MSA licence. One off introductory day licences are available at the track for \$25. (These are also available online via Motorsport Aust website.)

Groupings will be as per normal GEAR Track Days, matched with similar cars participating in the practice day. So if you haven't been to Morgan Park previously this is your chance to try out this great track with its recent resurfacing.


