Did you know.....Lakeside was built on Sid Sakewski's farm using a lot of volunteer labour supplied by the young motor racing enthusiasts from QMSC

(Queensland Motor Sport Club) around 1959/60.

THE FIRST OFFICIAL RACE MEETING WAS HELD ON 19TH MARCH 1961.

The entry list contained an interesting collection of cars including:

- the HWM Jaguar (J Hough)
- The Ferrari Super Squallo (Des Kelley)
- A 5 litre Cadillac Special driven by R D Mason and
- many other makes, MG, Holden, Triumph, and Volkswagen.

Sid entered two cars, the Plymouth Belvedere and the first Porsche Carrera to come to Queensland. The Belvedere was raced on Sundays and used for the school run among other duties during the week. Note the plastic cover on the windscreen of the Belvedere.

ONE OF MY FAVS......

It's not just the awesome cars that drive around the track that we all love to see, but it's also the amazing cars that are parked around the track that makes GEAR such an enjoyable car meet and event.

I just had to feature one of my favourites, owned by Doug Matthews. What an astounding job, I just love this beast! Check out Doug's story below, it was also featured in the Cruzin magazine #263!

The hot rod is a 1940 Chev Truck cab that was made by HOLDEN's (yes it has an apostrophe S, check the tag on the firewall) and is mounted on an A model Ford Chassis....why you ask, because it seemed like a good idea at the time and also because that is what we had laying around. It did make for some interesting times for fabrication etc to get everything to fit and look normal.

Engine is a mild 350 Small block Chev, with twin 600 Holley carbs on an old school Edelbrock tunnel ram manifold. Gearbox is a Turbo 350 and the diff is from a '72 Camaro....wanted to keep it all as GM as I could. It goes ok, given the pickup only weighs about 800kgs and engine makes around 375HP....power to weight is a good thing sometimes. Fuel economy is average, gets 25 litres to 100 kilometres, but I didn't build it for economy.

I decided to keep the original paint and patina on the truck and that meant making the brand new tray match the 80 year old cab....after a bit of trial and error, I think we got the fake patina pretty good.

Interior remains fairly sparse, no carpet, simple bucket seats, bespoke one off handbrake lever that started life as an Al-Ko boat winch, shifter etc...Steering column is from a HX Holden and the centre console is a hand built one off that houses the radio.

Interior light is a Butlers rally light (sourced from regular GEAR spectator John Whelan) just to be different.

The Mobil logos are hand painted by myself and are a tribute to my grandfather who owned a Chev truck back in the '30's when he was a rep for Vacuum Oil Company, the forerunner to Mobil. His surname was Greasley, hence the name on the rear tailgate.

The artwork on the air vent is a tribute to my father who served in the Navy in WW2 and is credited with shooting down a Japanese Zero in the battle of the Coral Sea. The artwork is a copy of the artwork displayed on his patrol boat Fairmile ML825.

People ask what is it like to drive....I tell them it is loud, bumpy and hot.....and makes you smile every time you drive it.

If you see the pickup at a GEAR meet or out and about, feel free to come up and say gidday and have a closer look.
