GEAR- PASSENGER RIDES

Current July 2014

- 1. The President / GEAR Committee must be satisfied that the passenger ride driver is suitably experienced and competent to conduct a passenger ride experience with safety. Length of GEAR membership and/or race experience will be considered.
- 2. Driver must be a GEAR member and be "armbanded" for that day's driving.
- 3. All cars on the track at that time must have a passenger.
- 4. The car must be equipped with an approved or standard seat and restraint for the passenger.
- 5. The driver would drive at a reduced pace (80%)
- 6. The passenger must sign the QR indemnity form. If the passenger is under 18, the driver must sign the indemnity form as legal guardian. Proof may be required.
- 7. The passenger must also have suitable clothing and helmet.
